

PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE NOTIFICATION

The No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act requires that parents of students who attend (or will attend) a school that has failed to reach specific NCLB goals for two consecutive years be notified of the opportunity for their child to attend a public school that has not been so identified. Although Alvaton, Bristow, Richardsville, and Warren Elementary Schools have made regular improvement since the 2001-02 school year, they fell short in meeting state and federal goals on some of their student subpopulations. As such, the schools have been classified in School Improvement I.

Therefore, you as a parent may choose to withdraw your son or daughter from one of these schools and enroll him/her according to the following choices list:

Alvaton may choose Cumberland Trace or Plano

Bristow may choose North Warren or Oakland

Richardsville may choose North Warren or Oakland

Warren Elementary may choose Lost River or Natcher.

Transportation provisions will be assumed by the school system. If you wish for your child to transfer, please contact your school principal to complete the application process. Application deadline is Thursday, October 13, 2011. Phone numbers are:
